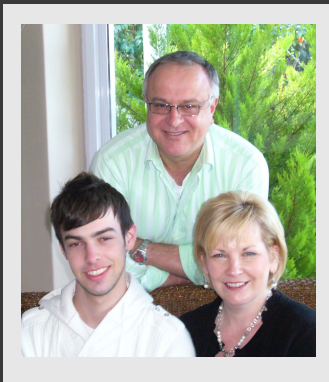
Hope for a Generation in Crisis

We have once again been disappointed by the collapse of the sale of our home in Cape Town. After two and a half months of negotiations, the buyer was unable to secure his mortgage. So we urgently need new renters there. Consequently we are unable to buy a house in Knysna as we had hoped, so we will move into another rental property the end of November. We will appreciate your prayers for God's provision in these matters.

God is at work in the three church planting projects we are working with here in Knysna. Two of the churches are in the poor township community (Lubabalo Baptist & Community Baptist), and one (Lagoonside Baptist) is in the middle class area of town. We recently started a Tuesday evening outreach study in our neighborhood and we

are encouraged with the 12 people who attend each week, some of whom have not attended our Sunday services yet. The response to the teaching has been encouraging. Please pray as the Gospel takes root in the hearts of those who attend.

Our "soup kitchen" ministries in three impoverished areas of the township continue as usual each week. We mainly focus on feeding malnourished, HIV infected children and we follow the feeding time with a Bible club on Wednesday afternoons. What a difference this small initiative is making in the lives of almost 100 children! Building trust and relationships with the community in this way, gives better access to Pastor Ngesi for evangelism and discipleship. We also have a "safe house" for abused women and children which presently provides emergency housing for up to



nine people. We have now raised 80% of the funds to build our second phase to give us space for another 9 women and children. Hopefully work on that should begin within the next few weeks. Please pray for God's grace for those who sacrificially minister to these needy people.



Thank you for being our partners in church planting along the Garden Route. We count it a privilege to live here and to serve our Great God in this way. Our prayer is that our small efforts will be multiplied for the glory of God, and for the eternal benefit for all who respond to the gospel.
